Intricate off-shutter concrete formed the framework of this complex project. This was further challenged by the logistical demands through its location on the top of a koppie overlooking Tshwane. The Museum was characterised by extensive rock cladding, water features, granite and stone walkways and elaborate internal finishes. Perimeter walls were clad with 76 000 plaques on which the names of individuals who died in the fight for freedom, were engraved. This contract was executed in Joint Venture with Concor.
