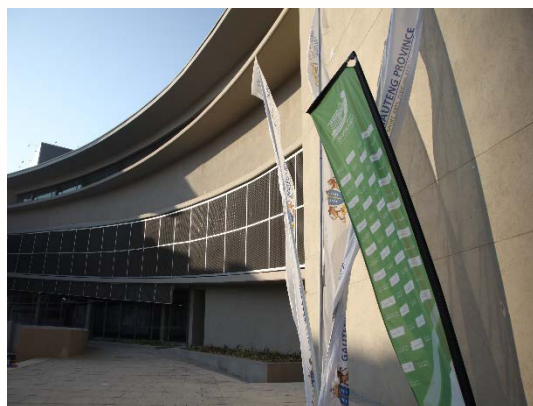


Women's Living Heritage Monument (JV)

The superstructure will be placed on its own pedestal floor layer that will be supported by its specific columns and foundation in the basement. The works comprise of a three storey concrete framed structure with brick in-fills. Dedicated Heritage and Artwork specialists have been employed carry out the sculpture and arty components.

The Women's Living Heritage Monument is to:

- Provide a sustainable narrative exhibition centre aiming at commemorating different roles played by South African Women across the country during the Freedom struggle and all activities women were involved in before 1994.
- To memorialize all women who took part in the 1956 women's march to the Union Buildings.
- To provide the interpretation of all activities to link the Heritage Monument with the Union Buildings.
- To provide space for formal and informal training for women.
- To provide market access platform for local crafters.

The Trencon Black Jills JV is challenged to achieve a significant number of work opportunities for women and local companies during the construction process.
